RESOLUTIONS TO BE PRESENTED

RESOLUTION 2018-11 OF THE SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PERSONNEL ACTIONS

Pursuant to the Authority By-Laws, the Personnel Committee shall advise the Board on issues related to organization structure, equal employment opportunity, labor negotiations, employment practices and personnel actions affecting an individual's employment status or compensation. This resolution seeks Board approval for personnel actions as specified in the "Schedule A" attached to this resolution.

RESOLUTION 2018-12 OF THE SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT TO JULIANO'S ATM SERVICES, OF LINWOOD, NEW JERSEY FOR AUTOMATIC TELLER MACHINES (ATMS) FOR THE ATLANTIC CITY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND THE TRAVEL PLAZA AT THE FARLEY SERVICE AREA

On February 16th and February 17th, 2016, the Authority advertised a Request for Proposals for Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) at the Atlantic City International Airport and the Travel Plaza at the Farley Service Area. On March 8, 2016, the Authority received four proposals in response to said advertisement. On March 22, 2016, the Authority's Consultant Selection Committee met and selected Juliano's ATM Services of Linwood, New Jersey as the highest ranked proposal. In April of 2016, the Authority, via Resolution 2016-35, entered into an agreement with Juliano's ATM Services of Linwood, New Jersey for a term of one year with two mutually agreeable one-year options to renew. The Authority via Resolution 2017-21 authorized the first one (1) year renewal option which is to expire on or about June 26, 2018. The Authority and Juliano's ATM Services mutually desire to extend the agreement for the second and final one-year renewal option.

RESOLUTION 2018-13 OF THE SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH GOBIS & COMPANY, LLC FOR OUT OF HOME ADVERTISING PROGRAM CONSULTING SERVICES

The Authority, via Resolution 2016-50, entered into a two (2) year agreement with Gobis & Company, LLC for Out of Home Advertising Program Consulting Services. The agreement, which is set to expire on June 30, 2018, provides the Authority with the option to extend for two additional one (1) year periods. During the two-year contract period, Gobis & Company provided valuable assistance to the Authority in managing its billboard assets. The Director of Business Administration recommends exercising the first one-year option to renew the contract with Gobis & Company at the same rates and conditions as in the original contract.

RESOLUTION 2018-14 OF THE SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ARAWAK PAVING COMPANY, INC., OF HAMMONTON, NEW JERSEY FOR THE ATLANTIC CITY EXPRESSWAY 2018 RESURFACING PROGRAM

On January 30th & 31th, 2018, the Authority publicly advertised for bids for the Atlantic City Expressway 2018 Resurfacing Program. As part of this solicitation, the Authority sought three separate Base Bids., wherein the work limits for each varied and the selection of the base bid is contingent upon available funds. Work includes but is not limited to furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials and performing all work required to resurface the following limits: Base Bid #1: Westbound Atlantic City Expressway from Milepost 43.0 to Milepost 38.0, the Interchange 41 Off-Ramp and On-Ramp, the Interchange 38 Off-Ramp and On-Ramp and the restriping of the Eastbound and Westbound Atlantic City Expressway from McGahn Bridge to the Pleasantville Toll Plaza (Milepost 0.4 to 4.5). Base Bid #2: The limits to Base Bid 2 are the same as Base Bid 1 except for reduced limits to the Westbound Atlantic City Expressway from Milepost 43.0 to Milepost 38.3 and eliminates the Interchange 38 Off-Ramp. Base Bid #3: the limits of Base Bid 3 are the same as Base Bid 1, except for increased limits to Westbound Atlantic City Expressway from Milepost 43.0 to Milepost 37.5. On February 21, 2018, five (5) bids were received, opened and tabulated. Following a review of the bids, the Authority deemed that the Base Bid No. 3, of which limits are indicated above, represented the best value for the Authority. Arawak Paving Company, Inc., of Hammonton, New Jersey was deemed to have submitted the lowest responsible bid for the desired Base Bid #3. The Authority desires to enter into a contract with Arawak Paving Company, Inc., for the Atlantic City Expressway 2018 Resurfacing Program, Base Bid No. 3, in an amount not to exceed \$1,829,000.00.
